New Border Measures Apply

New Japan's Border Measure to enter Japan.

(as of Sept. 7, 2022)

From 0:00 am (JST) on September 7, 2022, based on the New Border Measures (31), among those entrants from countries/regions where the B.1.1.529 Omicron variant becomes dominant (all countries/regions except for those where COVID-19 variants other than the Omicron variant become dominant), persons who possess [a valid vaccination certificate of COVID-19](#) (validity of which is certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) and the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare (MHLW)) and which proves that three doses of COVID-19 vaccine stipulated in the Annex 2 of the Measures (28) are inoculated.) will be no longer required to submit [in the certificate of negative result](#) of pre-departure COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to departing from the original country/region. (NEW)
